UNESCO Memory of the World Regional List

- This year's UNESCO Memory of the World Regional List is set to celebrate human exploration, innovation and imagination.
- Accordingly, it was decided to include the 15th century manuscript of Tulasidasa's 'Ramacharithamanas', which tells the story of Lord Rama, and the 15th century manuscript of the Panchatantra stories
- In this regard, in a recent report published by UNESCO, 'Khalkha Mongols Family Chart, House of Genghis Khan, photographs of Hoopshou communities in China are also included in the catalog as evidence of regional family history.
- Years before helicopters and solar panels were invented. They are fictionalized by Bangladeshi science fiction feminist writer S. Rogia Hussain's 1905 copy of 'Sultana's Dream' which is also included in the list.
- Similarly, 20 objects from the Asia-Pacific region are included in this list.

Aditya L-1 captured the impact of the solar storm

- Aditya L-1 spacecraft recorded the impact of a powerful storm created by a solar flare, ISRO said.
- On May 11, the impact of a strong electromagnetic storm created by an explosion in the 'AR-13664' region of the Sun was felt on Earth.
- It is the most powerful solar storm since 2003.
- In turn, various X-rays passed through the earth. They hit the earth for days. More and more such events are expected in the coming days.
- However, its impact in India was less. Also, the superheated plasma solar wind is blowing in that region.
