Bombay Group blood

- The Bombay Group is extremely rare. Only one in two and a half lakh people have this blood type.
- Last, in 1952, this blood type was discovered in Bombay by Dr. Pende. Thereafter, it was named Bombay Group.
- Normally antigens are present in red blood cells in blood and antibodies in plasma. Based on this, one's blood type is determined.
- But, in the Bombay blood type, the antigens are absent. Antibodies are the only ones present. So. It is classified as OH and HH.
- This cannot be detected in a normal blood test, but only in a plasma test.
