Decline in Birth Rate Over Six Years

- 11% Decline: In the last six years, Tamil Nadu's birth rate has decreased by 11%.
- 2024 Data: Only 8.41 lakh births were recorded compared to 9.45 lakh in 2019, marking a decline of 1.03 lakh births.

Why is the birth rate declining?

- Effective implementation of family planning schemes.
- Increase in women's education and career opportunities.
- Rising marriage age, reducing childbearing years.
- Preference for smaller families due to modern lifestyles.

Pros and Cons of Declining Birth Rate

- Advantages: Improved education, healthcare, and quality of life; better resource distribution; reduced maternal and child mortality rates.
- Disadvantages: Potential reduction in Tamil Nadu's parliamentary representation; less central funding based on population; increased aging population; labor shortages.
