<u>28 District Rural Local Body Representatives' Tenure Ends -</u> <u>Government Appoints Special Officers</u>

- Elections for the three-tier rural local bodies, including Gram Panchayats, Panchayat Unions, and District Panchayats across 28 districts of Tamil Nadu, were conducted in 2019 by the Tamil Nadu State Election Commission.
- Prior to this, elections should have been conducted for these rural local bodies. However, due to pending tasks such as ward delimitation work and the merging of several panchayats into urban areas, the Tamil Nadu government informed the Madras High Court that elections could only be conducted after completing these tasks.
- As a result, special officers have been appointed to manage the three-tier rural local bodies whose tenure has ended.
- In Gram Panchayats, the public can pay tax and non-tax revenues online via http://vptax.tnrd.tn.gov.in/, and these collections
 must be monitored.
- Efforts should be made to ensure clean drinking water supply and sanitation in all residential areas under the panchayats.
- Duties and responsibilities must be carried out following the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, government orders, rules, and guidelines, as mentioned in the government order.

Tamil Nadu has 6.36 crore voters; Female voters outnumber males

- According to the final voter list, Tamil Nadu has a total of 6,36,12,950 voters, comprising:
 - 3,11,74,027 males,
 - 3,24,29,803 females,
 - 9,120 third-gender voters.
- The Sholinganallur Assembly Constituency has the highest number of voters in Tamil Nadu, whereas the Keezhvelur Assembly Constituency in Nagapattinam District has the least.
